Texas Cavalry - Regiment - Rossis Brigade, Confederate Army.

Later in the war he was transferred to John P. Gatewood's scouting company, which operated in front of Chattenooga, and did great service in holding the out-laws or camp followers from Thomas's army at Chattanooga in proper bounds.

W.D. Broughton was commander of the Texas squadron in Gatewood's scouting company.

After my escape from prison at Indianapolis, Indiana, I landed back South, and joined Gatewood's scouts and W.D. Broughton's squadron, and served with him continuously until all the departments of the Confederate army had surrendered,

I know him to be among the bravest of the brave, and the truest of the true, to the cause he represented.

The above statement of facts is true to the best of my knowledge and belief.


