Before me, the undersigned authority, on this day personally appeared W. L. Richardson, and L. V. Taliaferro, both of whom are well known to me, and who are trustworthy citizens and credible and worthy of belief, who being by me duly sworn on their oath state as follows, viz: We, the affiants both knew J. S. Gordon, who now resides in Anderson County, Texas; we have known him for many years; we knew him during the Civil war; we serwed with J. S. Gordon in the Civil war; we all belonged to Company A, 38th. Tennessee Regiment; by Col. Robt. Looney of Memphis, Tenn;, our Captain was H. W. Cotter; the said Gordon made a good and faithful soldier; Gordon enlisted in 1861, at the same time we did; Gordon served in this command with us about two years, during which time he was faithful and did his full duty; after he served two years with us he was granted a furlough to go home to take a sick brother; during this time he was cut off from our command and could not reach it to get back on account of the Northern army, and the said Gordon then joined, Barnes Company, and Faughter Rem Regiment, which was under command of General Forrest, where he served until 1865; we were not with him under his last command but from heresay and otherwise we know he made a good soldier in his new command; but he was with us some two years, and never deserted and made a good soldier; we saw him most every day during this time and hence out knowledge is personal; we knew no other J. S. Gordon
