It is shown by the Confederate records that Reuben F. Crook, first sergeant, Company E, 8th Battalion, Georgia Infantry, Confederate States Army, was enlisted May 8, 1862. On the muster roll of that company, dated August 31, 1864, he is shown as "Absent without leave, June 12, 1864." The Union records of prisoners of war show that this man, while a deserter from the Confederate States Army, subscribed to the oath of allegiance at Chattanooga, Tennessee, June 24, 1864. The Union records also show that he took the oath of allegiance at Louisville, Kentucky, June 28, 1864, under condition to remain north of the Ohio River during the war.
